





Maverick Wines are made 100% from fruit biodynamically grown from our owned vineyards in unique sites across the Barossa and Eden Valleys. The average age of our vines is over 100 years old. The combination of biodynamic viticulture and virtually dry farming gives low yields of intense fruit which in turn are the perfect raw material for making exquisite wines. Our winemaking is truly artisanal. The vineyards and the winery are registered as biodynamic/organic by NASAA (the National Association of Sustainable Agriculture of Australia). Our wines are fruit driven, but complex, elegant, the perfect accompaniment with food, and above all outstanding value. From the outset, Maverick has been a 5 star winery in the James Halliday Australian Wine Companion, and again in the 2013 edition has received 5 red stars, with no less than 5 wines receiving scores of 94 points and above.



Maverick Trial Hill Eden Valley Riesling 2010

95 points

Brightquartz-green; immediately proclaims its class, lime juice and lemon sherbet driving the wine from the start to the long, invigorating finish. More to come a bonus.

Maverick Twins Eden Valley Chardonnay 2009

92 points



Bright straw-green; the grapes were picked at the right moment, the flavours ripe, the acidity fresh; stone fruit, fig, cashew and citrus are all to be found on the well-balanced and long palate, fruit and oak in harmony.

Maverick Trial Hill Eden Valley Chardonnay 2006

94 points

Very skillfully made; seamless nectarine and white peach fruit and oak; citrusy acidity.

Maverick Twins Barossa Grenache Shiraz Mourvedre

Deep in colour, with an attractive fresh black fruit bouquet offset by spice and mineral aromas; the palate is unctuous and generous, fresh and lively, with attractive and refreshing tannins on the finish.

Maverick Twins Barossa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon



Merlot Petit Verdot Cabernet Franc 2008 95 points Deep, clear crimsonpurple; Maverick keeps pulling lovely wines in the face of adversity; this is a stellar achievement in 2008, with smooth, supple blackcurrant, mulberry and cassis fruit, fine tannins, good oak and great balance.

Maverick Twins Barossa Shiraz

2008 94 points



Deep crimson; ripe blackberry and plum fruit on the bouquet, the medium - to full bodied palate showing very good restraint; the finish is full of character; likely picked before the heatwave.

Maverick Greenock Rise Old Bush Vine Barossa Vallev

Grenache 2009

94 points



Mid-garnet, bright; the bouquet is a pure, red-fruited offering, with sage and thyme also on display; warm and generous on entry, then a fine backbone of acidity and a complex finish of Provencial herbs and juicy.

Maverick Paraview Barossa Valley Shiraz 2008



Medium red-purple; from the Paraview Vineyard in the Stonewell area, this wine must surely have been picked before the hearwave; that said, it is full-bodied, with a panoply of red and black fruit flavours, the tannins and oak perfectly integrated.

Maverick Old Ben Eden Valley Shiraz 2008 / 2009



95 points / 96 points Intense purple-crimson; this estate vineyard has three small blocks (total 3.2 ha) of 90-year-old shiraz; the wine is densely packed with spicy black fruits that expand progressively in the mouth; clever oak handling has added another layer in support of the fruit, and the gently savoury tannins have been precisely judged.

Maverick Greenock Rise Barossa Valley Shiraz 2009

95 points



Healthy crimson-purple; while full-bodied like all of the '09 Maverick Shirazes, has a degree of elegance tracking the supple, rounded and very long palate, replete with black cherry, blackberry and spice.

Maverick Trial Hill Eden Valley Shiraz 2008





From the 1.6-ha estate vineyard high in the Eden Valley. The strong colour and very complex aromas and flavours are a tribute to the site; the fruit is predominantly in the black spectrum, leavened by quality oak, fine, savoury tannins and hints of spice and licorice.
